Safety Corner

Winter is a good time to go through your motorcycle to make sure it is ready to roll safely when the warmer weather hits. Proper bike maintenance is very important for safety no matter what time of the year it is. I will highlight some areas in this section for you to consider. These areas are not all inclusive and your motorcycle should be maintained per the service manual at the required intervals. If you don't feel competent or comfortable performing these items, get with Stephen at the dealership to schedule your maintenance.

- Oil Levels. Check for proper level. Is the oil in the primary, trans, and crankcase clean or has been changed recently? Dirty oil can contain acids that will corrode the inside of your engine during storage.
- Air Cleaner element clean?
- Check the drive belt tension and condition.
- Check tires for wear and abrasions.
- Clutch cable lubed, Clutch adjusted properly?
- Brake pads in good condition?
- Battery hooked to a tender for long term storage?
- Spark plugs worn? Replaced at required interval?
- Brake fluid level OK?
- Check for oil and fluid leaks.
- Check sprockets for wear.




